In Q3, ARHI successfully launched **new clinical trials in Naples and Immokalee** Florida, strengthening our role as a trusted provider of advanced medical research and accessible patient care in Southwest Florida.

Community Impact:

- Free, **advanced medical oversight** for eligible local residents.
- **Compensation per participant** to help cover time and travel.
- **Expanded outreach** in Naples, Immokalee and neighboring communities, including Bonita Springs, Marco Island, and Fort Myers.

IF YOU ARE A PATIENT WITH A HISTORY OF ATHEROSCLEROTIC CARDIOVASCULAR DISEASE (ASCVD) THIS IS YOUR TIME!

We are looking for participants for a PHASE III STUDY ON MAJOR ADVERSE CARDIOVASCULAR EVENTS (MACE) in patients with a history of Atherosclerotic Cardiovascular Disease (ASCVD) events or at high risk for a first event.

PARTICIPANTS WITH HISTORY OF AN ASCVD EVENT:

1. > 18 years of age at the time of signing the ICF
2. LDL-C ≥ 60 mg/dL
3. T2DM requiring ongoing medical therapy

PARTICIPANTS AT INCREASED RISK OF A FIRST ASCVD EVENT:

Male participants ≥ 50 years of age or female participants ≥ 55 years of age at the time of signing the ICF with LDL-C > 100 mg/dL (> 2.6 mmol/L) and diagnostic evidence of at least one of the following disease categories:

1. CAC score > 300
2. Current tobacco use
3. Age ≥ 65
4. T2DM (if included on the less significant atherosclerosis criterion III)
5. Lp(a) > 125 nmol/L, 6. hs-CRP > 2.0 mg/L. *Additional criteria apply.*

QUALIFIED PARTICIPANTS MAY:

- Receive compensation up to \$1400
- If all visits are completed
- Receive access to study medication
- Have access to study doctors

- Documented stable triple/dual inhaled therapies* for > 3 months prior to enrollment

- Receive compensation up to \$770 if all visits are completed
- Receive access to study medication
- Have access to study doctors

 - Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
 - Cough

 - Chills

- Muscle pain or aches
- Headache
- Nausea
- Vomiting
- Diarrhea

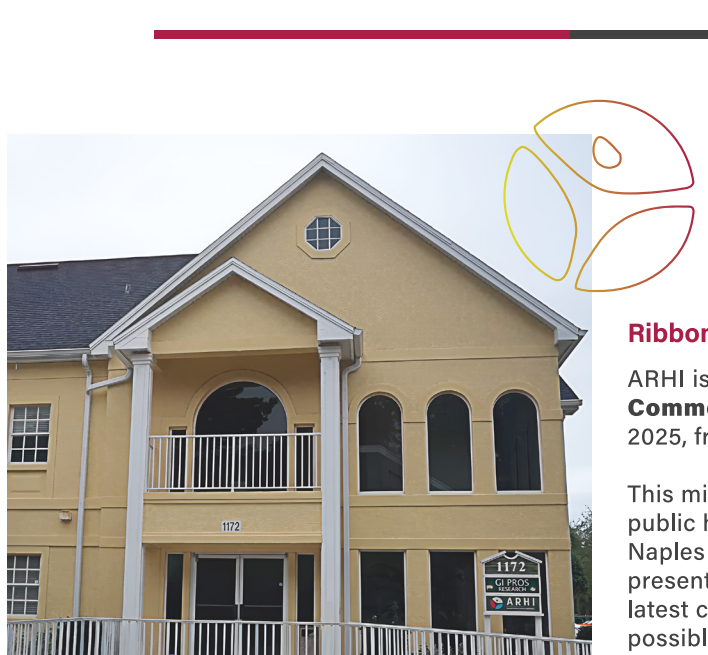
EVENTS
